

King Alphege is awarded to the class with the highest percentage attendance each Week







Year 1

We have had a marvellous week in Year 1, starting off with a lovely trip to Whitstable Castle and Gardens where we played in the swings, enjoyed ring games on the green and ate our packed lunches picnic-style under the trees. Thank you to all the lovely parents and carers who came along to support us, it was wonderful to share our outing with you.
