Available for preschool-aged children only. This service runs in other parts of Kent.



We started the week with a Circus workshop in the main hall. Sunbeams were enthralled by the juggling Phil demonstrated, which was also very funny and caused much laughter. Then Sunbeams had a go at juggling scarves before they walked the tightrope and spun plates. It really was a lot of fun! We have been writing our nativity this week which we will be sharing with you on the 19th. Our nativity is in the children's own words so expect some interesting embellishments to the Christmas Story you know! We have been practicing our songs and next week we shall start our rehearsals in the main school hall. Next Tuesday afternoon we will be welcoming any of our Sunbeams families who can make it, into the setting for a stay and play between 2pm and 3:15pm, so please do come along and join your child in play.

Year R Mrs Keeble and Mrs Jones

We have really entered into the festive season this week and the excitement is growing for our nativity performances on Tuesday and Wednesday next week. We can't wait to share our singing, acting and skills as musicians! The children really enjoyed sharing their festive crafts with those of you who were able to come, thank you! We loved Circus Day and had great fun balancing on a tightrope, spinning plates and juggling. Our children have really impressed us with the respect that they have shown as we have gradually joined with the rest of the school for collective worship: on Tuesday we have singing worship with Mrs Memmott and on Thursday there is celebration worship. Next term we will also join worship on Wednesdays. Next week we will all be walking to St. Alphege Church for our Christmas worship together: all families are welcome to join us on Monday 2:30pm. In Maths this week we have been learning about the properties of circles and triangles and in phonics we are coming to the end of this term's sounds – you can recap all of our sounds at home using the sticker in your reading record. Our phonics reading book was Tap it Tad! There has been a technical problem at Big Cat Books but hopefully now you can access seven phonics books online.

Year 1 Miss Hughes and Mr Mead

We have been feeling the excitement of Christmas in Year 1 this week, and we are all very excited it is now December! We have been opening our class advent calendars each morning and counting the days until the 25th! We have been practising our concert songs each day this week – maybe you could ask us to sing you one at home. We can't wait to sing them to you on the 18th! For our Creation Week in English, we became news reporters and told the world about the danger of the Big Bad Wolf and the events that happened to Little Red and her Grandma. We even filmed ourselves and used props like microphones to make us look and feel like real news reporters! We had lots of fun watching these back in our classroom all together! In Maths we have been learning about fact families and the relationship between numbers. We have been writing subtractions and additions using three numbers, and remembering that additions create big answers and subtractions create small ones. We have been making our own toys in our Design and Technology lessons and these are coming home with us when they are finished! Year 2 Mrs O'Keeffe and Mrs Cook

What a fun and busy week we've had in Year 2 this week! In English it was Creation Week, and we have been writing a guide on how to look after our planet in lots of different ways including recycling, donating clothes to charity, and using reusable bottles instead of plastic ones. The children used imperative (bossy) verbs to write rules and conjunctions to extend their sentences. The writing was amazing and next week we are looking forward to using our work to create a poster about saving our planet. In Maths we tackled the tricky topic of column addition. We have finished our addition and subtraction topic now and will be moving on to 2D and 3D shapes, focusing on identifying them and discussing their properties. In Art this week we recreated the work of Jackson Pollock with an exciting carousal! The children created works of art using string, marbles, pipettes and spoons! Next week we will be doing lots of Christmas crafts and art, including creating paper chains, handprint wreaths, and Christmas cards.
